



NG Huntsville Campus Security Information for Visitors (Domestic Only)

Visitors must have required information for gaining access to the facility, i.e., current valid photo ID (drivers license, military/ government ID card, passport). If the visit is to attend a classified meeting, clearances should be sent as instructed below. To confirm VAR, contact Leah Brannon (256-830-3548)

The preferred method for sending/receiving visits is via DISS (SMO Code 9F9096). Visits may also be sent via fax to (256) 830-3265). Visit requests must be on company letterhead and be signed by the Company Security Manager if being faxed.

Security Rules


